| | Made from 100% Verdejo grapes. The palate is fresh and elegant with pronounced notes of tropical fruit. | |
| 5 | Muscadet de Sevre et Maine Sur Lie . FRANCE | £26.95 |
| | A crisp and dry wine from the Loire region of France. Full-flavoured with refreshing sea tang. Great to enjoy with shellfish. | |

| | This off-dry wine is a great all-rounder. Fresh aromatics and soft stone fruit flavours. | |
| 9 | Dr Loosen Estate Riesling . GERMANY | £28.45 |
| | Fresh and vibrant notes of peach and citrus fruits on the palate. Well balanced acidity and refreshing medium dry finish. Naturally light in alcohol, at just 8% abv. | |
| 10 | Lawsons Dry Hills Pinot Gris . NEW ZEALAND | £30.95 |
| | Fresh citrus aromas are matched with apple and peach flavours. A classy wine with great length on the palate. After gentle pressing, the resulting juice was fermented 90% in stainless steel at cool temperature, with the balance put into French oak puncheons for a slow gentle fermentation. The wine is then left to rest on the yeast lees to give weight to the palate. | |

| | A French classic. Sancerre is Sauvignon with a finesse found only in France. Justifiably popular and famous. | |
| 14 | Chablis 1er Cru Vau Ligneau, Alain Geoffroy . FRANCE | £40.95 |
| | Made from 1er Cru grapes by top quality producer Alain Geoffroy. Full flavoured with great fruit presence and a long, dry finish. A perfect example of this Burgundy classic. Burgundy has a higher number of appellations (AOC's) than any other French region and is often seen as the most terroir conscious of all the French regions. | |

Red Wine Selection

Light & Fruity

Good with heavier meats, pork or duck dishes

- 22 **Vina Ventisquero Pinot Noir Reserva** . CHILE **£26.75**
Excellent Pinot Noir from the Casablanca Valley. Light red fruit and great finesse.
- 23 **Fleurie Cave de Fleurie** . FRANCE **£31.45**
One of the best known of the Beaujolais Cru. Light to medium weight with a fresh, dry finish. Made from the grape of Beaujolais 'Gamay' A thin skinned grape variety with low tannins giving a light and delicate red wine.
- 24 **Lawsons Dry Hills Pinot Noir** . NEW ZEALAND **£36.45**
This expressive Pinot Noir has lifted aromas of plums and violets. Ripe berry fruits combine with savoury notes on the palate to produce a wine that is both elegant and approachable.

Smooth & Easy Drinking

Drink on their own, or with grilled meats, sausages and roasts

- 26 **Cepas Bonarda Malbec** . ARGENTINA **£23.45**
Dark, full-bodied and smooth, with a hint of soft spice.
- 27 **Santiago Rioja Crianza** . SPAIN **£25.45**
Lovely raspberry, damson and sloe fruit flavours with streaks of fine, toasty vanilla and ripe tannins.
- 29 **Mio Passo Primitivo** . ITALY **£26.95**
A full-bodied wine oozing flavours of black cherries, with spicy notes. Very smooth with long denouement.

Spicy & Warming

Perfect with tomato and pasta based dishes, and spicier food

- 30 **Rioja Adivino Tinto** . SPAIN **£21.95**
This young Rioja has a delicious red berry fruit and a perfect touch of oak. Fantastic with lamb!
- 31 **Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Dea del Mare** . ITALY **£24.45**
From Montepulciano and Sangiovese grapes. The wine is dry and soft, with plenty of depth.
- 32 **Spier Signature Shiraz** . SOUTH AFRICA **£26.45**
Inviting aromas of ripe plum, caramel and hints of spice on the nose.
The aromas follow through to a sweet and creamy palate with soft tannins.

Full & Intense

Perfect with red meats and steaks

- 33 **Lyngrove Pinotage** . SOUTH AFRICA **£23.45**
From South Africa's signature red grape. Spicy blackberry aromas and juicy berry fruit on the palate.
The finish is smooth and rounded.
- 34 **Smoking Loon Old Vines Zinfandel** . USA **£31.45**
California's signature red grape variety. A unique and exciting wine, packed full of ripe dark fruit.
The Zinfandel grape is genetically identical to the Italian grape Primitivo, although the Californian climate and terroir gives a slightly different style of wine. Usually a big, bold wine.
- 35 **Chateau Puy Blanquet "Grand Cru" St Emilion** . BORDEAUX, FRANCE **£40.95**
Bordeaux is the largest wine growing area in France, producing predominantly Red wine known as Claret. This wine is a classic blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Cabernet Franc. Complex flavours of blackcurrant and cedar with soft tannins.
The region has many of the worlds most famous wine villages, and produces the most expensive and exclusive wines worldwide.
- 36 **Chateauneuf du Pape, Juliet Avril** . FRANCE **£50.95**
Fine aromas of cherry and raspberry. The palate has a creaminess with soft tannins. A fantastic wine, deserving of its excellent reputation. Chateauneuf du Pape is located in the Rhone region, South Eastern France. Up to 13 grape varieties are permitted by AOC rules to produce these famous wines. Grenache and Syrah being the most common
- 37 **Botter Amarone Della Valpolicella** . ITALY **£60.95**
Due to the drying of the grapes, (a process known as Appassimento), this concentrates their sugars and flavours, giving a very powerful full bodied wine with a high level of alcohol. Amarone is the name of a style of wine, not the region that the wine comes from. It is produced in the Veneto region of Northern Italy.
