#### Day 2 - Bridgnorth

Bridgnorth Low Town sits on the River Severn whilst the High Town is accessed by the Bridgnorth cliff funicular railway or winding steps. Full of independent shops and cafes, Bridgnorth market is held on Saturdays. Walk along the clifftop to visit the leaning castle or take a trip on the Severn Valley Railway.

Shrewsbury has a castle, a riverside park and lots of independent shops, cafes, pubs and restaurants. The award-winning Market Hall Shrewsbury is full of artisan products and fresh local produce. The Town Square hosts a Monthly Farmers Market (1st Friday) and the Made in Shropshire Market (2nd Saturday).
